### ***Did you know...?***

- Last year, CEF donated more than \$178,000 to the Chatham Public Schools.
- Since CEF's inception, nearly 250 grants have been funded for all children of Chatham public schools.
- CEF funds programs in all educational disciplines for every student.
- Over the past two year, the number of technology pilot programs CEF has awarded has increased 200%
- More than half of all grants CEF has funded are for Language Arts and Science programs at all 6 Chatham public schools.
- CEF has provided grants for the climbing walls at both WAS and SBS.
- The majority of the grants CEF has awarded over the past decade are still being used today.
- Over the last 11 years, CEF has donated nearly half a million dollars to enhance our children's education.
- CEF's efforts would not be possible without the generous support of our community.

The Chatham Education Foundation, a non-profit organization, began in 1997 by a volunteer group of concerned parents and community members who wanted to enhance the excellence of public education in Chatham through private funding. Since its inception, the Chatham Education Foundation has awarded more than 250 grants totaling half a million dollars to fund special projects throughout Chatham public schools, either as district-wide gifts or through grants awarded to teachers for use in their classrooms.
